


## WARNING FLOOR TIGHTENING JACK

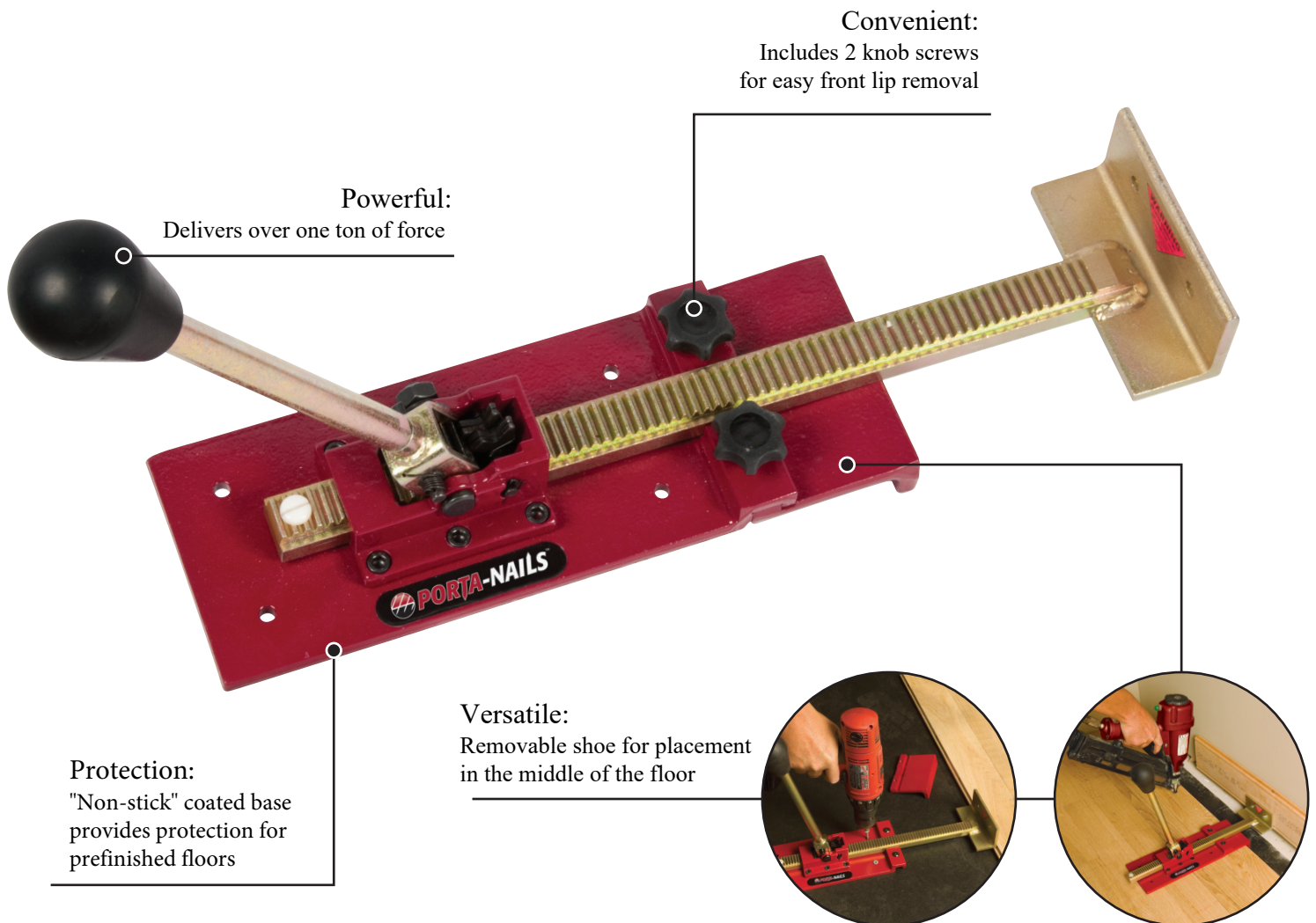

The Porta-Jack Pro tightens and holds flooring strips in place for nailing, and is great for straightening crooked or bowed flooring strips. Can be used up against walls and in the middle of the floor on solid and engineered wood flooring.

To use the Porta-Jack Pro: place it on the flooring as depicted above and move the handle forward and backward. This will extend the pusher plate along the rack and pinion ratchet and either push against the flooring or the wall plate. Take care to not over extend the push rod, keep the plastic button a few inches away from the ratchet mechanism. To release the tension move the handle all the way forward (towards the push plate) this will release the two locking pawls.
